Revelation 20 contains one of the most fascinating prophecies found in the Bible. This thousand year period of time is called the “millennium,” from two Latin words, mille, meaning “one thousand” and annum, meaning “year.” This thousand year period of time is bound by two different resurrections. Like two book ends on a book shelf, you have the resurrection of life at the beginning and the resurrection of damnation at the end.
